

Getting Connected (Using phone as modem, via cable connection)

Please refer to the user manual that accompanied your mobile phone. Different phone manufacturers provide different ways of getting connected to Internet by using the USB cable.

In general, most phone manufactures provide "PC Suite" software which enables a Phone to be connected to PC via a USB cable. Via this PC Suite software, users can connect their PC to the Internet by making use of the Phone as the Broadband modem. You can either install the PC Suite software from the CD or download it from the manufacturer's website.

Upon successful installation of the PC Suite software, connect the cable (normally USB) supplied together with the phone to the PC. Launch PC Suite software and click on Connect to Internet to get connected. Normally this would take 20-30 seconds. If it doesn't get connected, check on the settings. The Access Point Name (APN) should be "celcom3g" and the dial up number is *99#.
